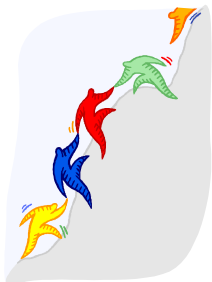

Theology Theater: Acting Out Our Faith



This is going to be a very different retreat!! Usually at retreat sessions teens sit, listen to the leader and then discuss the topic. Sometimes there is a craft or art project related to the theme. This is how retreats go. But not this time.

This time, *you will be the theme. You will be the story. You will be the creators.* Adult staff will be here to help guide you and facilitate your creation, but for the most part you will be the leaders. At this retreat you will be making a movie.

You will spend your session time exploring faith, spirituality and what being a Swedenborgian means. Together, in community with your friends, you will create a plot, write an original screenplay, develop storyboards, build a cast of characters, construct scenes, act and film.

Throughout the past year, some local youth groups have watched YouTube videos about God, religion and the afterlife. I searched YouTube for Swedenborgian videos on these subjects and found little to nothing. I need your help. Teens know far more than adults about videos, YouTube, what works, and what is interesting. I have witnessed time and time again your imaginative, inspiring and original creations. A Matter of Balance

Have you, or do you know someone, who turned down a chance to go out with family or friends because they were concerned about falling? Have they cut down on a favorite activity because they might fall?

Many older adults experience fear of falling and restrict their activities. During these sessions, participants learn to view falls and fear of falling as controllable and set realistic goals for increasing activity. We also find ways you can manage your surroundings to reduce fall risk factors and learn simple exercises to increase strength and balance. ***A Matter of Balance: Managing Concerns About Falls is an award winning program sponsored by Southern Maine Agency on Aging.*** The program acknowledges the risk of falling and emphasizes practical coping strategies to reduce this concern.

A Matter of Balance: Managing Concerns About Falls is being offered in Fryeburg for the first time. The sessions will be held at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church hall, 857 Main Street, Fryeburg, on Tuesdays and Fridays, May 11th through June 4th, 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM. Program cost is \$20. A workbook is provided and refreshments are served.
