Being In Balance

It's been a week since the power went out and I'm reflecting on how destabilizing it was, even though I didn't want to feel negatively impacted by the effect of no electricity. But it threw me out of balance and that was uncomfortable.

Swedenborg talks about the balance that exists throughout creation. That all things are kept in equilibrium by the Lord, and that is what holds all of creation together. Too little or too much of something on one side or the other disrupts the balance.

The recent snowstorm and power outage was an example of "too much".

Too much snow on the branches caused them to break.

Too many broken branches on the power lines caused them to short out.

Too many shortages in the lines had the whole electrical system down.

The emergence of too much brought about a shut down of the electrical system throughout the State.

And that caused a lot of disruption in our outer lives.

Our inner lives operate like that as well.

Too much stress, too much to do, too much thinking distressing thoughts can move us out of balance and lead to a breakdown of our inner world. But, just like a weather forecast, there are signals that can tell us we're moving out of balance so we can adjust. And when we don't, like my microphone on Sunday, that tried to give me clues that it was about to run out of power, we sometimes miss the signals. And then... we're out of power.

Luckily there are people who there who can help us anytime we feel out of balance. Noticing the signals gives us a chance to pause, to pray, and to reach out for help. The Lord is always there to bring things back into balance, and the sooner we catch the signals, the sooner we will be back feeling balanced, steady and strong. May the month ahead be a balancing one for us all.
