Greetings dear Readers!

Haydn, Swedenborg and Fowler

What do a composer, a mystic and a theologian/psychologist have in common? Well....let me tell you a little story about how these three will be coming together for us through Lent.

I've recently joined a choir, and on Monday nights I head to Center Conway for choir practice with the Mount Washington Valley Choral Society. This semester the choir is singing "The Creation" by Joseph Haydn, and will be performing in May, alongside an orchestra and soloists. "The Creation" is an opera-type performance based on Genesis 1 - the story of creation.

Following choir practice, the bible verses that we've been singing continue to flow through my mind all week.

I imagine the creation story and can't help but reflect on the correspondences and the inner meaning that Swedenborg teaches us about. According to Swedenborg, at one level the story of creation in Genesis presents an outline of the process of our spiritual growth and transformation, which he calls Regeneration. As I sing, I consider the message of Genesis and what it means for my spiritual growth at this point in my life.

As a former psychotherapist, I've also been considering the psychology of our Regeneration process and how that transforms our minds and spirits. I'm reminded of the work of James Fowler, a theologian and master of psychology, and the author of "Stages of Faith". This is a book which explores the psychology of human development and outlines six main stages relating to the development of faith. Fowler defines faith as our way of making sense of the world and finding the meaning and purpose for our own lives.

Putting these three together naturally led to the idea for a Lenten study, and so I will be offering a class to explore the correspondences in the story of creation.

We will meet after church, at 11:30 am for about an hour, beginning February 25th. You can participate online through Zoom, or in-person in the church hall. We'll explore the correspondences of Genesis 1 and see what Swedenborg has to say about our spiritual growth. Then we'll add Fowler's Stages of Faith model and see how they line up. There will be time for sharing our personal experiences and reflections. Bring your lunch and invite your friends. I'm looking forward to joining together with you to explore this rich, spiritual text.


FNC NEWS

Please let us or the church office know. Thank you.




FRYEBURG FAIR MEETING

The Fryeburg New Church held its 2023 Annual Meeting on Sunday, January 28, with 21 members present.
