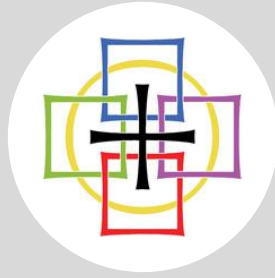

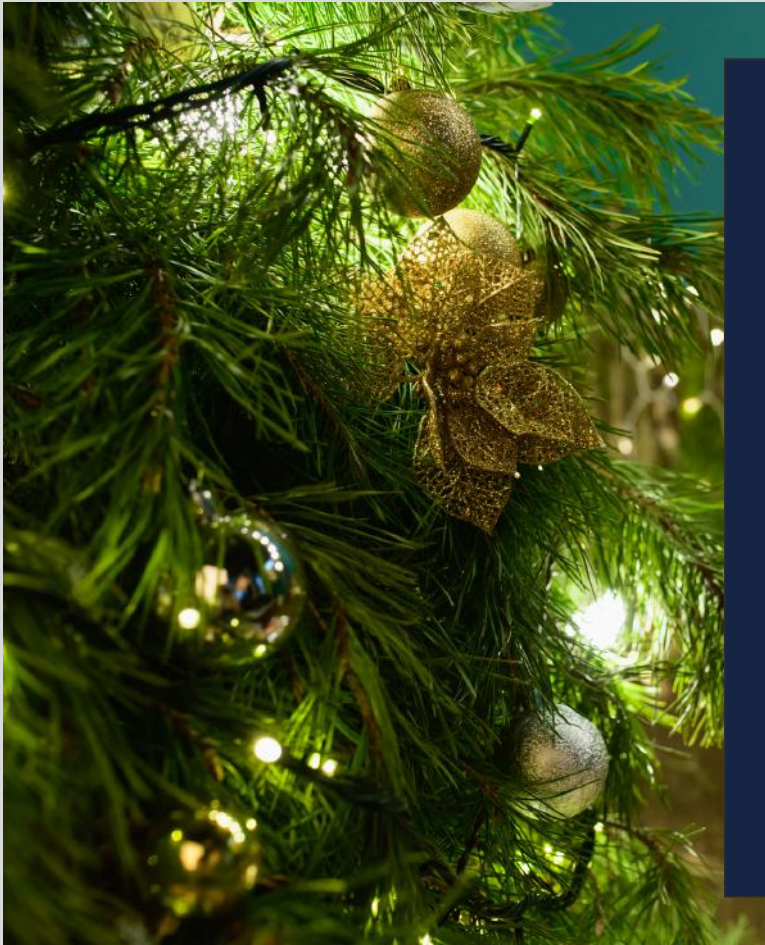
PayPal is an online financial service that allows you to pay for items using a secure internet account. You simply choose the bank account, credit card or debit card that you want to use when making a donation.

REMEMBERING AND HONORING OUR LOVED ONES

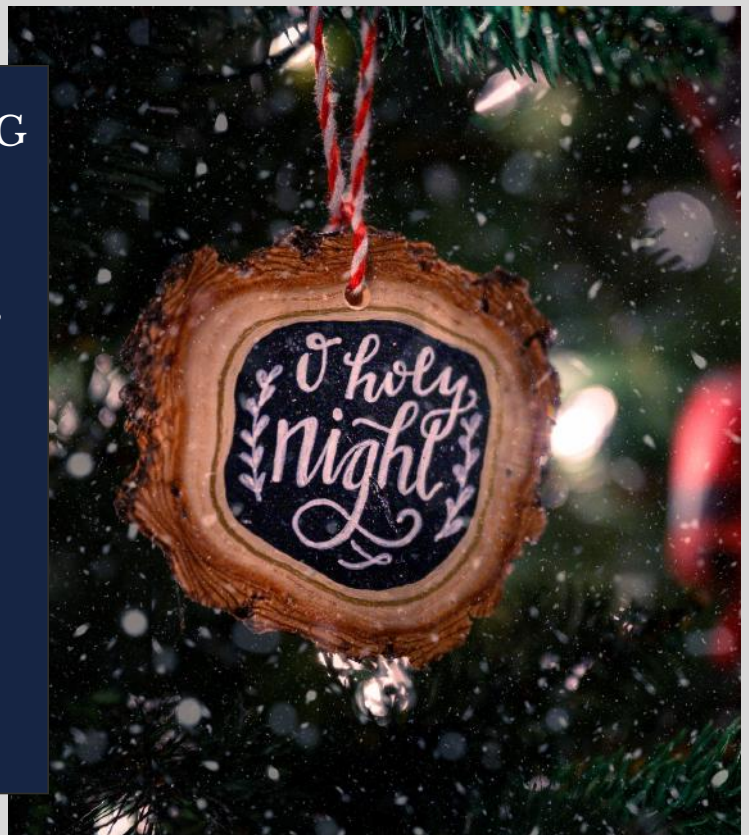
